

Imagination, journeys, hope, isolation




The Arrival by Shaun Tan. Lothian Books (wordless picture book)

Journeys, refugees, loss. Family, difference isolation





Immortality, curiosity, knowledge, death, time





Belonging, fitting in, being lost, having a place in the world, friendship, responsibility




### The Tunnel by Anthony Browne. Walker Books

Mayfly has only one day to live but she enjoys every moment: mortality, making the most of life, nature, enjoyment




